Dear Parent/Carer,

I would like to invite you to collect a remote learning book and google classroom log in details for your child from school. If at all possible, please can you drop into school via the office before 4.30pm today in order to collect this.

Inside the pack, you will find guided reading, English and maths activities, which will be referred to in the coming half term. Also, in the front of the remote learning book is a username and password for Google Classroom and underneath is the login details for TTRS.

I would be very grateful if you could bring in any reading books your child has and they will be exchanged for one new reading book. There are lots of reading activities in the orange reading record books that would be great for the children to work through. If you are unable to come to school today, please email me and I will provide you with the log in details as soon as possible. However, in any case, if you could please prioritise collection of the pack that would be most appreciated. If your child is in school, then please disregard this request as they already have these details.

During this new lockdown, Google Classroom will be used for some learning links and for the Google Meet facility. A Google Meet will be held for Year 3 at 9.45am tomorrow (Wednesday, 6th January) - so please log in using your child's google details in advance and familiarise yourself. A Google meet link should appear on the Year 3 banner at the top of the page in the morning for the Google meet at 9.45am. I hope to meet with the whole class most mornings for a preparation session, which will hopefully prove useful! Tomorrow will be a familiarisation session and over the coming days, we will all get quicker! We are all learning together, so I apologise in advance if there are technical issues.

May I also remind you that if you have issues printing any worksheets (black and white is fine) - please let me know as these can be prepared in advance for you and collected from school if necessary.
