This report will actually cover the last 2 years, given the situation with COVID-19. Although we saw a lot of the usual fundraising activities cancelled throughout 2020 and 2021, the PTFA still done their upmost to raise funds for school resources & extra-curricular activities for the children wherever possible, but ultimately the success of prior years' fundraising helped greatly toward ensuring the children didn't completely miss out & funded some nice Christmas surprises in 2020.

Sadly, the 2021 Y4 leavers also missed out on the usual Richards Evening celebration, like those in 2020. However, a really nice alternative was compiled, by the teachers, which was then broadcast with the aid of Google Classroom for all Y4 children & parents to join & watch remotely together, with parents then presenting their children with a lovely gift box during the individual presentations section, which the PTFA funded.

By late 2021 the PTFA organised a Halloween trail, an outdoor disco, Christmas fair & also contributed to the Snow Queen Panto, all of which the children really enjoyed & were a great success from a fundraising perspective. Once into 2022, the Spring Sing Raffle, Danceathon, Jubilee & Gin Tasting done wonders for the fundraising pot, with the Danceathon raising a staggering £1,814.14 in sponsorship alone!!
