

**Year Group: Three**

**Term: Summer 2**

## English

In their English lessons, children will look at the book Journey. Children will be using this book to support their writing to produce character descriptions, stories, diary entries, and letters and setting descriptions. The book Journey has no text, so this book really inspires children to use their imagination.

This term, children will be using this book to incorporate speech, inverted commas and fronted adverbials. Children will also be encouraged to use ambitious vocabulary by using a thesaurus and applying this to embed detail for the reader.

## Maths

In maths, children will be learning about properties of shape and focusing on turns, right angles and angles. Learners will develop their understanding of vertical and horizontal lines as well as parallel and perpendicular lines. Children will also focus on mass and capacity this term by measuring mass and capacity and then using this skill to add and subtract these two different measurements.

## Science

In science this term, children will be learning about nature and conducting studies into the school ecosystems and recording what insects, birds and animals they observe in the school grounds.

## Physical Education

In PE, children will be focusing on cricket and developing their throwing, batting and catching skills to support their ability to field, bat and bowl. Children will also be taking part in outdoor adventurous activities.

### Hook for Learning

This term, children will be learning about the Rotten Romans and exploring what life was like for them and how they become the successful force that they were.

### Rationale

This topic enables children to build on their knowledge of Romans from the previous term but also allows their knowledge of chronology to build as they will be adding to their knowledge of the Stone Age and the Ancient Greeks.

### Curriculum Enrichment

Why were the Romans so successful? What did they bring to our country? Children will discover all about the success of the Roman's and what life was like for them.

### PSHEe

In PSHEe, children will be focusing on the theme of wellbeing. They will be thinking about what wellbeing is, they will develop strategies to support emotions, challenges and upcoming transitions.

In computing, children will be using Google Slides/Powerpoint to create an information powerpoint about their topic. Children will learn about the different features of power point and how to add font and pictures. As well as learning about slide animation and transition, to make pictures and text enter the slide in exciting ways
