### Summary of Sports Premium Proposed Spending 2014/2015

The Government has given every school funding to help develop Physical Education and competitive sport.

In our school we are using this funding in the following ways:

- Increase the amount of competitive sport in which our children participate.
- Buy in a P.E. specialist to lead P.E. lessons and support, develop and up-skill the teaching staff.
- Our P.E. specialist will foster and develop strong links with the wider community to enhance the P.E provision we provide in our school. In turn, this will lead to the promotion of healthy, life-long and active lifestyles.
- To use the P.E. specialist to supplement the lunchtime games and sports offered. This includes the training of *Young Leaders* and the implementation of the *Change for Life* programme.
- To increase the diversity and range of additional clubs which will strengthen and embed the skills taught in the curriculum.

### Impact of Sports Premium Spending 2013-2014

- Sainsburys School Games Gold Award achieved.
- Increased participation in inter school competitions – 66% of KS2 children participated in a range of tournaments.
- Pupil voice indicates increased enjoyment (see Governor's report).
- *Young Leaders* deliver active lunchtimes termly.
- Lessons are highly regarded.
- Specialist coaching bought in to deliver a high quality and more varied P.E. curriculum.
- P.E. co-ordinator attended termly network meetings with all schools and CPD opportunities offered by *Castele Consultancy and Progressive Sports*.
- New netball posts bought.
- Data has been collected on the number of pupils participating in extra-curricular sport. This is being repeated to ensure the impact is sustained.
- Reception class received *Soccertots* and Zumba sessions.
- Maintenance of 2 hours of timetabled physical activity per week with additional activities offered after school and at lunchtime.
- Profile of P.E. has been raised through P.E. stars award and reports about events shared in celebration assembly.
